

Dear Coach,

My name is Steven Prinz and I manage PT Ammo alongside my family out of East Haven, CT. We greatly appreciate the opportunity to offer your team and the USA Clay Target League ammunition for this upcoming Spring Season.

We are opening our Youth program on November 1st, 2022 and will keep our program open all year long. Ammunition is guaranteed to be delivered before the start of the Spring season, though it will typically be delivered 4-8 weeks after payment is received. We try to keep 2-3 containers in stock at a time, so depending on how soon your order is placed, you may receive ammo far earlier than 4-8 weeks. Below, I will explain our products and order process in more detail. Afterwards, I will explain our shipping and tax exemption policies.

Lastly, I included a testimonial from Bill Hoffman, a coach from the Dexter Trap Team. He conducted a test of PT Ammo using our 1330 FPS shells. Please note that all PT Ammo shells being sold in the future will be 1145-1200 FPS.

Products:

We carry our brand called PT Ammo. We use Cheddite and Nobel Sport components, including hulls, powder, primers, and shot. Here is a breakdown of prices, specs, and options:

PT AMMO:

12 Gauge, 7/8oz [#7.5,#8, #9.5], 1265 FPS	\$79/case
12 Gauge, 1oz [#7.5,#8], 1200 FPS	\$83/case
12 Gauge, 1 1/8oz [#7.5,#8], 1145 FPS	\$84/case
20 Gauge, 7/8oz [#7.5,#8], 1200 FPS	\$87/case

^{*}There is a **15 case** minimum order and no maximum. If you would like less than **15** cases, we can offer ammunition through our retail channel, though shipping costs are \$20/case through UPS. Smaller orders can be placed on our website and will be shipped via UPS.

SHIPPING:

Shipping costs are NOT included in the prices above. They vary based on location and quantity ordered. However, shipping for 65 cases and more will typically cost \$2-5/case. A full pallet holds **125-130** cases depending on weight and gauge. We use Old Dominion to carry our freight.

Once your order is placed, you will receive an email with the final quote including shipping costs and any applicable taxes. You will be able to click on the invoice and pay using credit/debit card, ACH transfer, or mailed check.

This is a **pre-pay** program, and your payment will secure your order and guarantee delivery prior to the season starting.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- 1. Depending on your state and quantity ordered, you may be eligible for free or discounted shipping. Shipping costs will be shown in your invoice.
- 2. Credit Card companies charge a **3% fee** for ammunition and firearm purchases. You can avoid this fee if you pay via ACH transfer which we highly recommend. There will be an ACH payment option embedded in the invoice sent to your email.

- If you live in New York or California, we are required to ship to an FFL. Please upload the name and address or FFL document using the file upload button.

About Us:



About our Business:



Currently, our ammunition is produced overseas, though we are working on starting manufacturing here in the states. We have an FFL type 8 importing license and AECA import permit.


- 1. Please go to https://checkout.prinztech.com

3. You can then choose which ammunition you need from the options. The title will include the gauge, weight, velocity, and price.




4. On the product page, please confirm that you can receive pallets and **choose your shot** size:



5. Upload any documents regarding Tax exempt status, FFL, Pistol Permits, and a State Issued ID prior to clicking the order button



6. Please check which payment method you would prefer (ACH transfers are the most cost effective as credit card companies charge a 3% fee)



7. Lastly, choose your quantity and press "Pre-order Now." You should receive an email invoice soon after where you can pay online.
